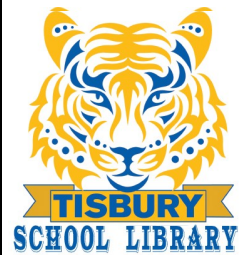

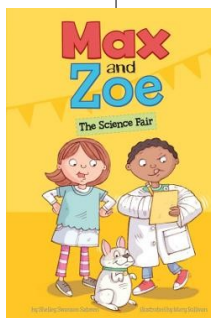

Tips to Encourage Reading:

- ◇ Set aside a regular family reading and/or read aloud time.
- ◇ Read to your children, even the older ones.
- ◇ Recognize that your child’s own choice and interests are important ingredients toward reading enjoyment.
- ◇ Let your child see you reading for pleasure.
- ◇ Pack a book wherever you go this summer.
- ◇ Encourage and help your child succeed with reading but do not push or expect too much too soon.
- ◇ Participate in activities at the [local library](#).
- ◇ Learn more about children’s books from your child’s friends, from the local library, or from the attached lists.

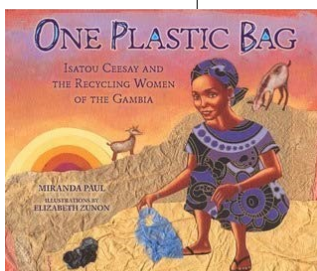
