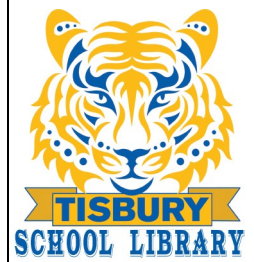

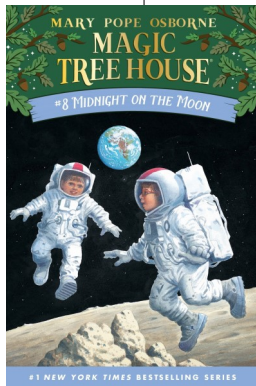

Tips to Encourage Reading:

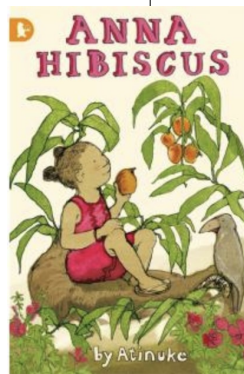
- ◇ Set aside a regular family reading and/or read aloud time.
